

# Shocker: No Pro-Israel PAC Benjamins to Omar, Tlaib or Ocasio-Cortez

As has been previously pointed out (see, for example, May 2017 *Washington Report*, p. 84), pro-Israel PACs, or political action committees, are no longer the brash campaign contributors of yore—having discovered that the requirement that all their activities be reported to the FEC makes those activities a little too public for comfort. In this era of dark money and massive bundling of individual contributions, these PACs are now described as being the “tip of the iceberg” of pro-Israel campaign contributions.

Still, information can be gleaned from these FEC reports, on which the following chart is based. It's instructive to note, for example, when the lobby uncharacteristically favors a challenger over an incumbent, such as when incumbent Missouri Sen. Claire McCaskill, a Democrat, received \$9,700 in pro-Israel PAC contributions versus \$23,178 to her victorious Republican challenger, Joshua D. Hawley.

At other times—and more frequently lately, it seems—the Israel lobby spends its Benjamins in vain. The top pro-Israel PAC recipient among House candidates was Rep. Peter Roskam (R-IL), who received a whopping \$67,352 to his opponent, and new member of Congress, Sean Casten's \$7,000. Apparently money was not enough to overcome the charges of corruption faced by the pro-Israel incumbent, who argued that supporters of BDS “actually want Israel destroyed.”

And who was runner-up to Roskam among House candidates? The answer lies not in who he was, but who he wasn't. Denver L. Riggleman, III was running against Leslie Cockburn for the open seat in Virginia's 5th congressional district—and Cockburn was co-author with her husband, Andrew, of the 1992 book *Dangerous Liaison: The Inside Story of the U.S.-Israeli Covert Relationship*. Needless to say, spu-

rious charges of anti-Semitism flew: Virginia's Republican Party chairman called her “the inspiration for neo-Nazis, white supremacists and racists.” It didn't matter that Cockburn met for two hours with 40 Jewish Virginians at the home of a Charlottesville rabbi, who, according to *The Washington Post*, “said Cockburn clearly supports Israel as a Jewish state and would have no problem voting for aid” to Israel. No deviation from the pro-Israel line is permitted, however, and Cockburn lost the race.

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## A Campaign Contribution Ratio of 83:1

Only two Arab-American PACs made contributions in the 2018 election, the AA Democratic Action Fund and Arab American Political Action Committee, for a total of \$20,700—less than a third of what Roskam alone received, and more than \$3 million less than pro-Israel PAC contributions last year. Since 1978, pro-Israel PACs have given 83 times the reported campaign contributions as have Arab-American and American Muslim PACs. It's no accident that U.S. foreign policy in the Middle East reflects that imbalance, especially in “the best Congress money can buy.”
